## School Digital Citizenship Plan 2025-2026

### About O.S. Geiger School and School Development Plan:

- 515 students in Kindergarten to Grade 6, including three specialized program classes (PLP and EES).
- Our students live in the communities of Castleridge and Cornerstone, 63% are English Language Learners, 4% identify as Indigenous, and 16% have special education codes to support their learning.
- SDP Year 2 – Literacy Goal: Students will improve in phonological awareness and decoding skills.
- SDP Year 2 – Mathematics Goal: Student engagement in math will improve through a focus on developing robust mathematical learning environments.

### Relevant evidence and data that informs your Digital Citizenship Plan:

- CBE Student Survey 2024-25:
  - 79% of students indicated that they learn new ways to use technology at school (7% decrease compared to last year).
  - 72% of students indicated that they understand what Digital Citizenship means at school (2% decrease compared to last year).
  - 28% of students indicated that they need the most support with using respectful words and actions when they're online and 27% indicated they need the most support learning how to be safe online and how to protect their personal information (2% increase compared to last year).
- Students in K- Gr. 2 typically access iPads for learning with technology.
- Students in Gr. 3-6 typically access Chromebooks and MacBooks to support their learning in the classroom.
- Students in EES Specialized Placement classes typically access iPads with inclusive technology to support their learning and communication.
